Dear Friends of Savary Island,

Great news, the Nature Trust and the Savary Island Land Trust (SILT) will proceed as partners in the appeal of the court decision on DL 1375 (formerly know as the “Trillium lands”). The two organizations will join forces and continue with this battle. SILT trustee, and distinguished litigator Chris Harvey, who has extensive experience in the appeal courts, will represent SILT on a pro bono basis to seek intervener status and consideration for the environmental impacts of the 8 lot decision.

Last week the Savary Island Land Trust raised \$50,000 in two days to support the Appeal. Thanks to all of you who contributed and made it possible for the Appeal to go ahead! The Nature Trust was thrilled with the support that came from you through SILT’s Earth Day fundraising effort.

The outcome of this case will be critical to the future of Savary Island
